## **About the Journal**

### **Focus and Scope**

The Journal of the Plant Protection Society publishes original research findings in the field of plant protection (Entomology, Plant Pathology, and Weed Science). In addition, it also includes research notes, short communications, and book reviews. Manuscripts from both within and outside the organization/country shall be considered for publication in the journal.

### **Publication Frequency**

The journal is published annually.

### **Peer-Review Process**

The Journal of the Plant Protection Society (JPPS), maintains a roster of qualified peer reviewers in the fields of Entomology, Plant Pathology, and Weed Science.

Research manuscripts received for publication in JPPS undergo preliminary scrutiny by the Editorial Board to assess their relevance to the Journal's scope and their overall quality, in accordance with the Author Guidelines. Manuscripts considered suitable at this stage are forwarded for further processing, while authors are informed if their manuscripts are rejected. Manuscripts approved by the Editorial Board are sent to peer reviewers along with an evaluation form for their comments and recommendations.

Reviewer comments are documented by the Editorial Board and communicated to the respective authors for revision. Authors are also notified in cases where manuscripts are declined.

Revised manuscripts that satisfactorily address the comments of the peer reviewers and/or the Editorial Board are accepted for publication. Manuscripts may be rejected if the required comments are not adequately addressed. The entire process of finalizing a manuscript for publication may take up to four months or less.
